### **Online Digital Prevention/Education Tool**

["The Trap"](https://www.ontario.ca/thetrap) (<https://www.ontario.ca/thetrap>) is a Human Trafficking Digital Education Tool designed to raise awareness about sex trafficking among middle and high school-aged children and teens. The interactive tool allows youth to experience what it feels like to be targeted and recruited by a sex trafficker through an immersive chat experience. It features scenarios based on real-life experiences and with the support of an adult facilitator, youth learn the skills they need to stay safe

### **Indigenous-Specific Materials**

Due to the impacts of colonialism, Indigenous women, girls, and 2SLGBTQ+ individuals are especially vulnerable to being targeted for recruitment by traffickers.
