

## **VQRP Supports**

Supports listed below are available to victims of Human Trafficking. They are available for up to 1 year after the date of the crime. The crime must have been reported to the Police **OR** an IPV shelter, hospital, Indigenous Social Service provider or other community victim support agency. VQRP requires confirmation that the victim is “out of the game”. When we process the application, we accept the word of the victim. There are maximum amounts that VQRP is willing to pay. We apply based on the individual needs, on a case by case basis.
